Video Criteria

- The device used to record the video can be a phone or an actual camera. Please keep in mind that quality of the video is important.
- Please make sure that:
 - Video is clear and of YOU. We want to see how and what you are playing/singing.
 - Video is audible and that we can hear you clearly. Listen to the video before sending it to make sure you can hear it clearly and are content with the result.
 - If you utilize a backing track (i.e. the song playing in the background), make sure YOUR volume level is significantly louder than the level of the backing track.

Submitting Your Video

1. Once you have reviewed your video and are content with the result, upload the video to your Google Drive.
